CODE OF CONDUCT



Code of Conduct

- The Certified Practising Celebrant (CPC) program is the Celebrant industry's peak measure of professional skill and commitment.
- To establish and maintain professionalism, ability and integrity of members is fundamental to the future success of Certified Practising Celebrant, its members, and the wider Celebrant community.
- As the Code of Practice, this document establishes principles that define the ethical behaviour of all members of the Certified Practising Celebrant program.
- It is expected that all members who are Australian marriage celebrants will also comply with the Code of Practice for Marriage Celebrants as contained in Schedule 2 of the Marriage Regulations 2017.
- A violation of this Code of Conduct may result in withdrawal of membership and post nominals may not be used.

The Celebrant agrees to adhere and be bound by the following:

- To accurately represent qualifications, credentials, and experience in both oral and written communication.
 - To maintain the highest levels of professional and business standards.
 - To promote the CPC name positively within the community.
 - To dedicate themselves to high standards of business, ceremonial, and personal performance.
 - To be a trusted colleague who respects everyone's privacy and always remains confidential.

- To respect the ethical expectations of other professionals with whom I interact in my celebrancy activities and the uniqueness and diversity of the learning community.
 - Reflect upon and evaluate their practice as part of their continuing professional development.
 - Will seek to be inclusive of every person.
 - A member is encouraged to share knowledge and experience with others.
 - Be open and respond positively to constructive feedback regarding their practices.

- Seek support, advice, and guidance where necessary.
 - Will extend kindness to all others.
 - Will take action to help a person in need if I see their need and can make the situation better.
 - Will respect differences of opinion by acknowledging the other person's stance and not pushing their acceptance of mine
 - To accurately advertise the CPC logo and postnominals in a dignified manner.

- To refrain from making false or unauthorised statements as representatives of the Certified Practising Celebrant organisation and agree to use the post nominals and logo only as authorised.
 - Will not share educational information gained in CPC with any other party.
 - A member will agree that the CPC Program Director has the reserves the right to moderate within networks and forums.
 - Where a conflict of interest arises, that member will be asked to leave, and a pro-rata membership fee will be returned. Use of postnominals will immediately be unavailable.
